We would like to extend our warmest welcome to all of our children and their families - staff have had a delightful first week with the children – they were settled during their first visits and staff are looking forward to the upcoming weeks as we continue to get to know all about them. We would like to give parents some initial information following on from induction 1-1 visits.



Dropping Off

The cloakroom is busy during drop offs. We ask that parents kindly hang up children's belongings, place their hand on the tree and walk children to the door. We would appreciate if you could then clear the doorway so that other children can enter the main room safely.



Passwords

We would ask that family members who collect children are aware of the password set during induction. This is the safest way to ensure that children are handed to the correct person whilst we begin to recognise faces.



Birthdays

We have a nut allergy in Nursery this year and to ensure safety of children we are asking if you choose to send in something for a birthday it is **sweets only**. We also ask that food items are not left in children's bags for safety.



Family Wish

We would also ask that those of you who have not yet sent in 'My Family's Wish for Me' please do so as staff have left a space for this in your child's Learning Journey. This sheet was given to you during your child's one to one induction meeting. If you have misplaced this please see staff for another copy or you may wish to fill one in when you attend the Parents as Partners session for your child.



Name Labels

We would ask that children have all coats, hats, cardigans, jumpers and shoes labelled. As children are managing their self-care more independently we would ask that you ensure labels are clearly visible in all of your child's uniform to help your child, as many of the children have the same sized clothing.



Toileting

As children settle into Nursery we will have toilet accidents as often children are absorbed in their play. Staff continue to prompt children and support them in their self-care. We ask that parents could send in spare clothing for children in a small bag. If your child has an accident we will place wet clothing into bags and a slip will be passed over to you when you pick up your child.

Nursery Fund

We would like to say a huge thank you to everyone who has contributed to Nursery Fund this half term. Winter warming snacks will continue to be available after the holidays on set days – please check the snack board in the cloakroom to see what choices are available.
