

Dear parent,
I write this 'extra' newsletter on a miserable Friday at the end of a week we all enjoyed! With the worries around Covid absolutely still with us, this is an opportunity to reflect on this weeks events for parents and a back up plan for Year 2 leavers disco during the last week of term.

At this point in time:

- Tuesday 29th June (afternoon) will be the filming of the Dance Festival
- Wednesday 30th June Class 5 and Class 6 to Newcastle Castle (separate buses, no class mixing)
- Thursday 1st July Class 4 to Newcastle Castle and Year 2 concert filmed outside (afternoon)
- Friday 2nd July Classes 1, 2 and 3 (separately) visit their new teacher and their classroom at FJS
- Year 1 concert performances (x3) outside: 9:15 Class 4, 10:45 Class 5, 2:15 Class 6 (1 parent per child)
- Year 2 concert performances (x3) will also follow outside on Thursday 8th July 9:15 Class 1, 10:45 Class 2, 2:15 Class 3 (1 parent per child).
- Year 2 leavers disco will also happen outside on Thursday 15th July, thanks to Magic Mick. With dry weather, the children will be in the 3 playground areas to ensure the class bubbles aren't breached. If the event needs to be indoors because of rain, the hall will be used for 30 minutes per class, quickly cleaned before the next class follows. Classrooms will be used for activities and tea in between.

Thank you for the patience and support of parents during the year group book sharing events this week. Things improved after Monday where arrangements had to be changed throughout the day. My apologies again for this. The real positive was that staff and parents have all commented that picnic rugs and deck chairs with social distancing on the field resulted in a very calm session that the children really enjoyed. With reception and year 1 classes performing their 'dance for parents', this offered opportunities to ensure parents saw their child which can sometimes be difficult in the main event.
